"Kids think they come here to play," says François Thibaut, founder of the French Workshop for Children. "But they leave each session with a grasp of fundamentals." And, judging by a recent visit, they leave with a working vocabulary and an accent parents will envy. Thibaut uses action games so that youngsters (four to fourteen) learn to take direction in French, skits to sharpen communications skills, plus workbooks and tapes. After-school classes (45 minutes long, once a week) are \$85 for seven weeks; Saturday classes (two hours long) are \$140 for seven weeks.
